They are in urgent need of the following **men's** clothing: Trainers/shoes – all sizes 8 – 12; T-shirts – all sizes; Jeans – waist 30", 32", 34", 36"; Trousers, eg corduroy, chinos – same as above (no suit-type trousers please); Jogging bottoms – all sizes, esp. M; Jumpers, hoodies – S, M, L; Travel bags/carry-on/small suitcases; Boxers (new only); Socks (new only). They do not need shirts or jackets, women's or children clothes.
